All Advisory Council agenda items, having been discussed during the Council meeting, are presented to the membership at the next annual business meeting of the Association. Agenda items may either be presented for action (by way of a motion), or a recommendation for no action.

NAEOP Affiliation year is August 1 to July 31. Affiliation is \$35 plus 10 cents per member for each local member based on the 4th quarter membership of the preceding fiscal year. New affiliations will pay \$35 plus 10 cents per association member. Renewal application and payment must be postmarked or emailed by September 15 to be eligible for awards, scholarships, and Advisory Council delegate.

- 1. Associations with local, state or area membership of 10 or less are required to have one person as an NAEOP member to affiliate.
- 2. Associations with local, state or area membership of 11–20 are required to have an elected officer & one additional person as NAEOP members to affiliate.
- 3. Associations with local, state or area membership of 21-50 are required to have an elected officer & two additional NAEOP members to affiliate.
- 4. Associations with local, state or area membership over 50 are required to have an elected officer & three additional NAEOP members to affiliate.
- 5. Affiliation will not be approved until all requirements are met. No refunds will be made after affiliation is accepted.
- 6. NAEOP does not endorse state/local association's fundraising activities.
